What is the overall deductible?	In-Network: Individual \$1,500 / Family \$3,000. Out-of-Network: Individual \$2,000 / Family \$4,000.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. For Participating providers: <u>Preventive care</u> , <u>emergency room care</u> , <u>urgent care</u> , <u>primary care provider</u> and <u>specialist</u> services are covered before you meet your deductible. For Non-Participating providers: <u>Emergency room care</u> is covered before you meet your deductible.	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. For example, this <u>plan</u> covers certain <u>preventive services</u> without <u>cost sharing</u> and before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . Are there other deductibles for specific services?	Yes. \$150 individual / \$300 family for <u>prescription drug coverage</u> . There are no other specific <u>deductibles</u> . What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan?	In-Network: Individual \$5,000 / Family \$10,000. Out-of-Network: Individual \$9,000 / Family \$18,000.	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <u>plan</u> , they have to meet their own <u>out-of-pocket limits</u> until the overall family <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> has been met.
What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?	<u>Premiums</u> , <u>balance-billing</u> charges, health care this <u>plan</u> doesn't cover & penalties for failure to obtain <u>pre-authorization</u> for services. Your Grievance and Appeals Rights: There are agencies that can help if you have a complaint against your plan for a denial of a claim. This complaint is called a grievance or appeal. Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes.

Minimum Essential Coverage generally includes plans, health insurance available through the Marketplace or other individual market policies, Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, TRICARE, and certain other coverage. If you are eligible for certain types of Minimum Essential Coverage, you may not be eligible for the premium tax credit.

Does this plan meet Minimum Value Standards? Yes.

If your plan doesn't meet the Minimum Value Standards, you may be eligible for a premium tax credit to help you pay for a plan through the Marketplace.
